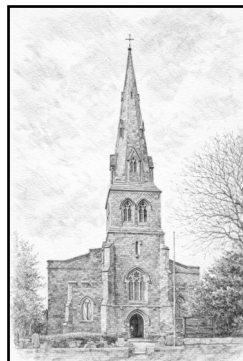
WEBELIEVE FESTIVAL

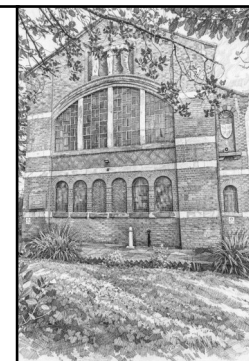
