The DSC have been looking at the various ministries and resources within the deanery (which consists of 8 parishes with 11 churches). And we have been asked to devise a 'Family of Parishes', which is a system where neighbouring parishes would be able to work cooperatively in sharing resources, and giving support in whatever way is needed. More information on how we will be working with other parishes will be available in the future.
