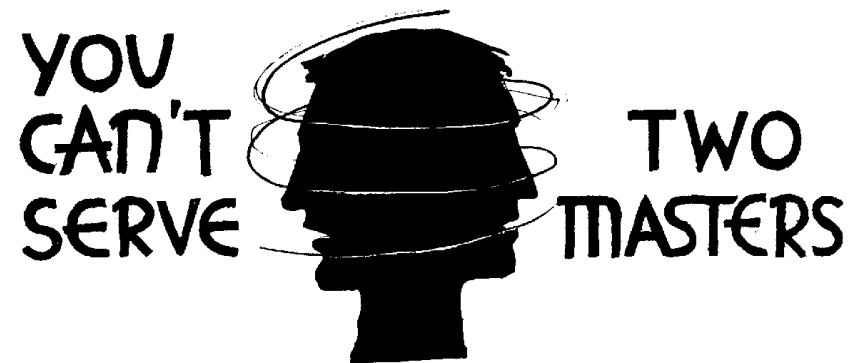

SAINT OSWALD'S MEMORIAL GARDEN

Our Memorial Garden is starting to look shabby and cluttered, due to the many old and faded flowers and ornaments that have been left.
