All Masses and services are celebrated in Saint Oswald's Church. Unfortunately at this time, Saint Sebastian's cannot reopen due to ongoing building works.

You no longer need to book a place to come to any of our Masses (unless you wish to make sure you have a particular seat), but you will still have to give your contact details at the church door. All other previous restrictions will still remain in place (social distancing, wearing of face masks, etc.). There is still a restriction on numbers allowed to attend Mass, but we can accommodate more people within our church. Funeral services will be celebrated within the church, but requiem Masses will not be celebrated at this time.

Until 17th May, the maximum number who are allowed to attend a funeral within the church is 30 people.

If you are at clinical risk of COVID-19, or have been told to shield, please follow the medical advice, and stay at home.

FUNERALS

From 17th May, the legal limit on numbers at funerals is to be removed as part of the roadmap for opening up after Covid. Venues can set limits on numbers based on their individual capacity, however; they must continue to be Covid secure, and must still follow the social distancing rules. **The number of people who will be able to attend a funeral within Saint Oswald's from 17th May will be 60 people.**
